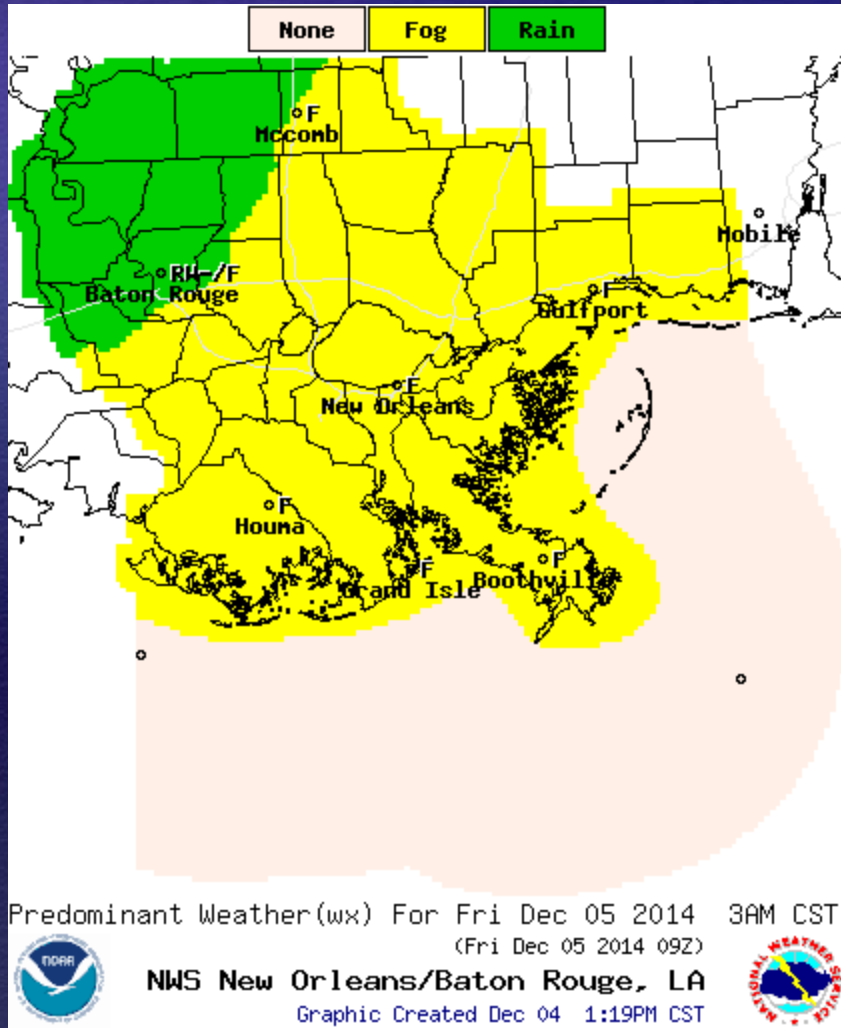
# Impacts Overview

- Dense Fog Possible Tonight and Friday Night
- Above normal temps through Saturday. Temps back to normal for next week. No freezing weather expected.
- Scattered showers possible Friday and Saturday.
- Another chance of showers the first half of next week.





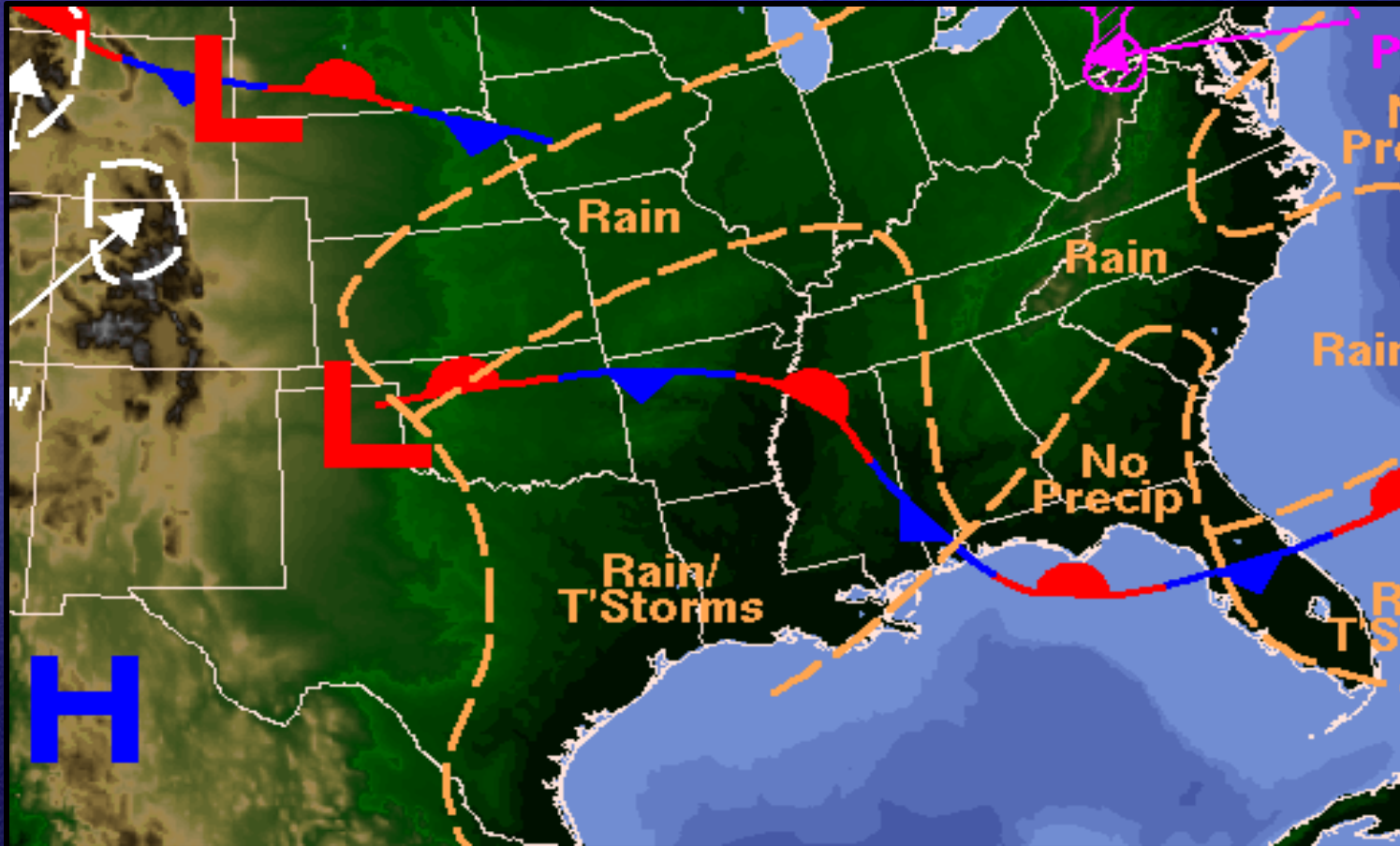
# Fog Threat Tonight



- Fog should begin to form around midnight.
- Fog will first form over coastal locations and over Lake Pontchartrain.
- Dense fog (visibilities of 1/4<sup>th</sup> mile or less) is expected by 3 AM over Lake Pontchartrain and coastal areas.
- Dense fog elsewhere by 6 AM.



# Friday

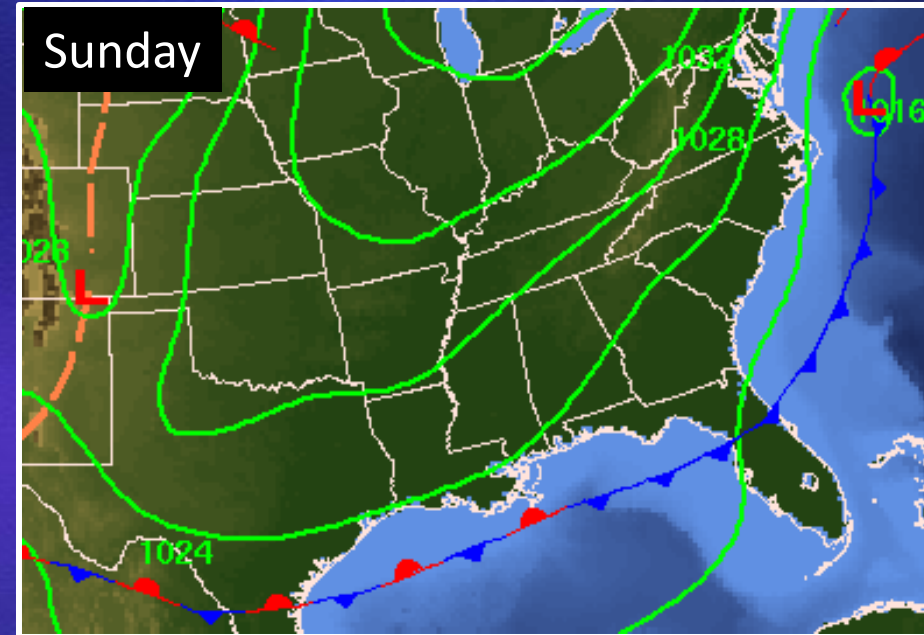
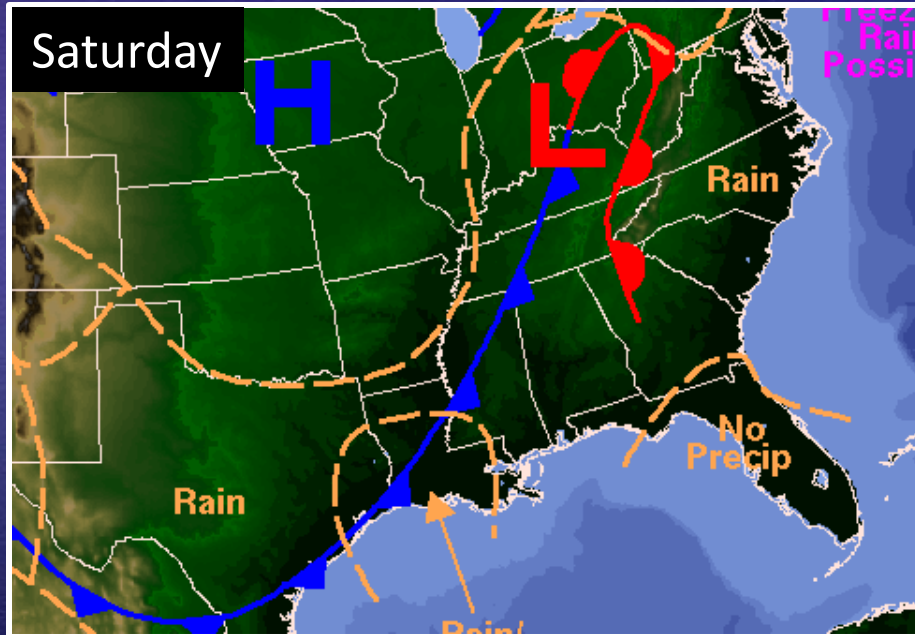


Morning fog will give way to cloudy skies and scattered rain showers.





# This Weekend



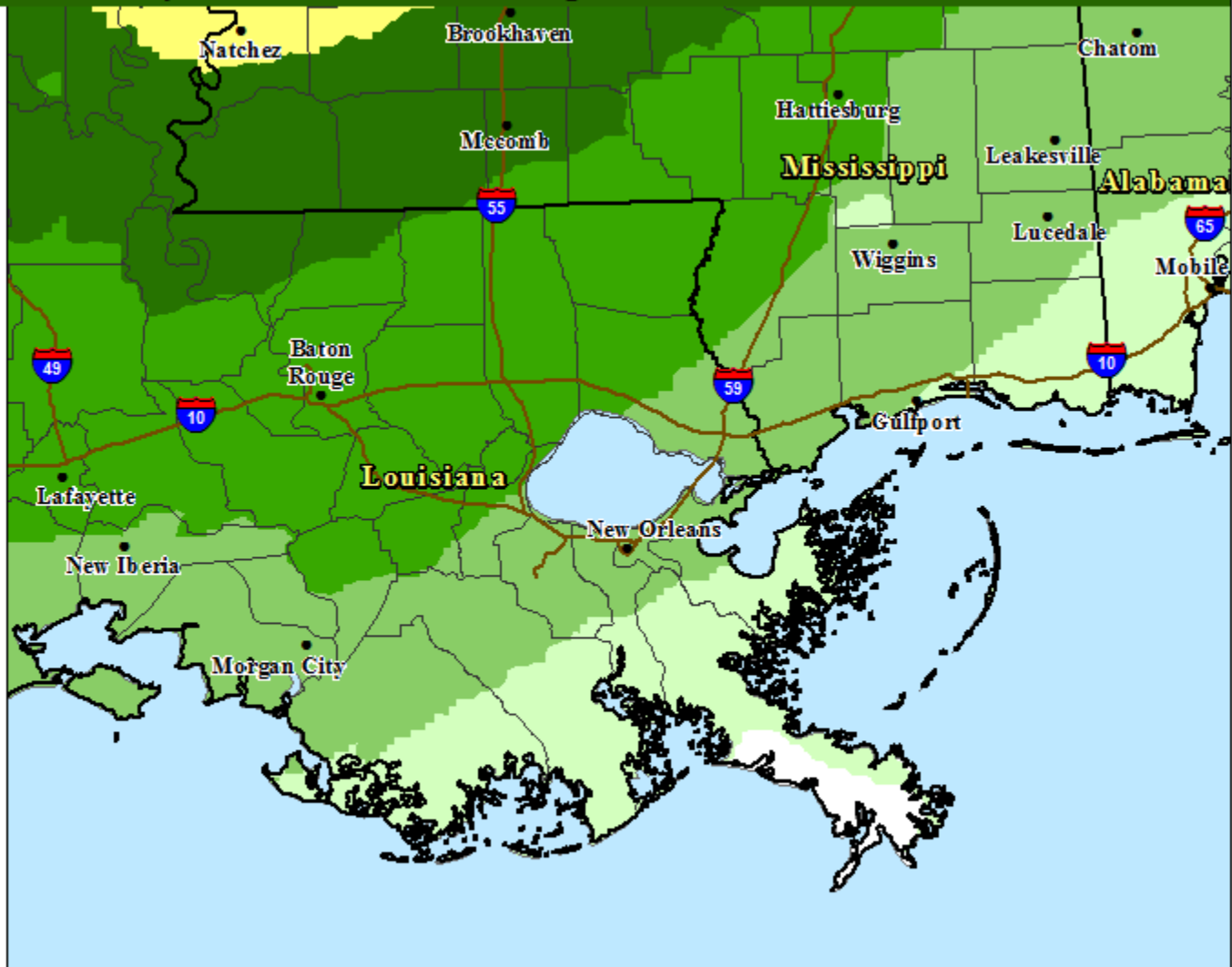
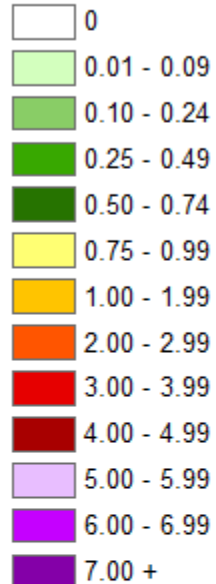
- Weak front will bring scattered showers to the area on Saturday.
- Dense fog will be possible Friday night into early Saturday morning before the front moves in.

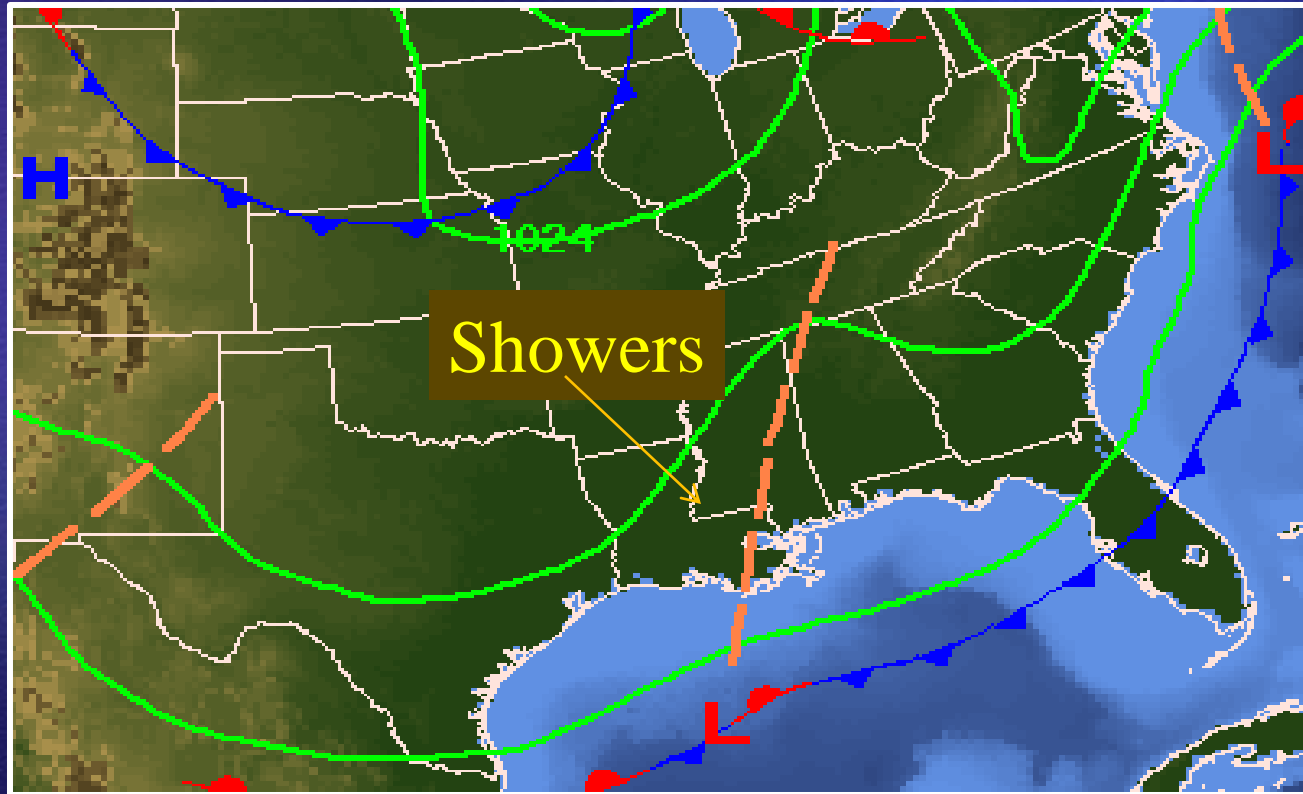

# Next Week

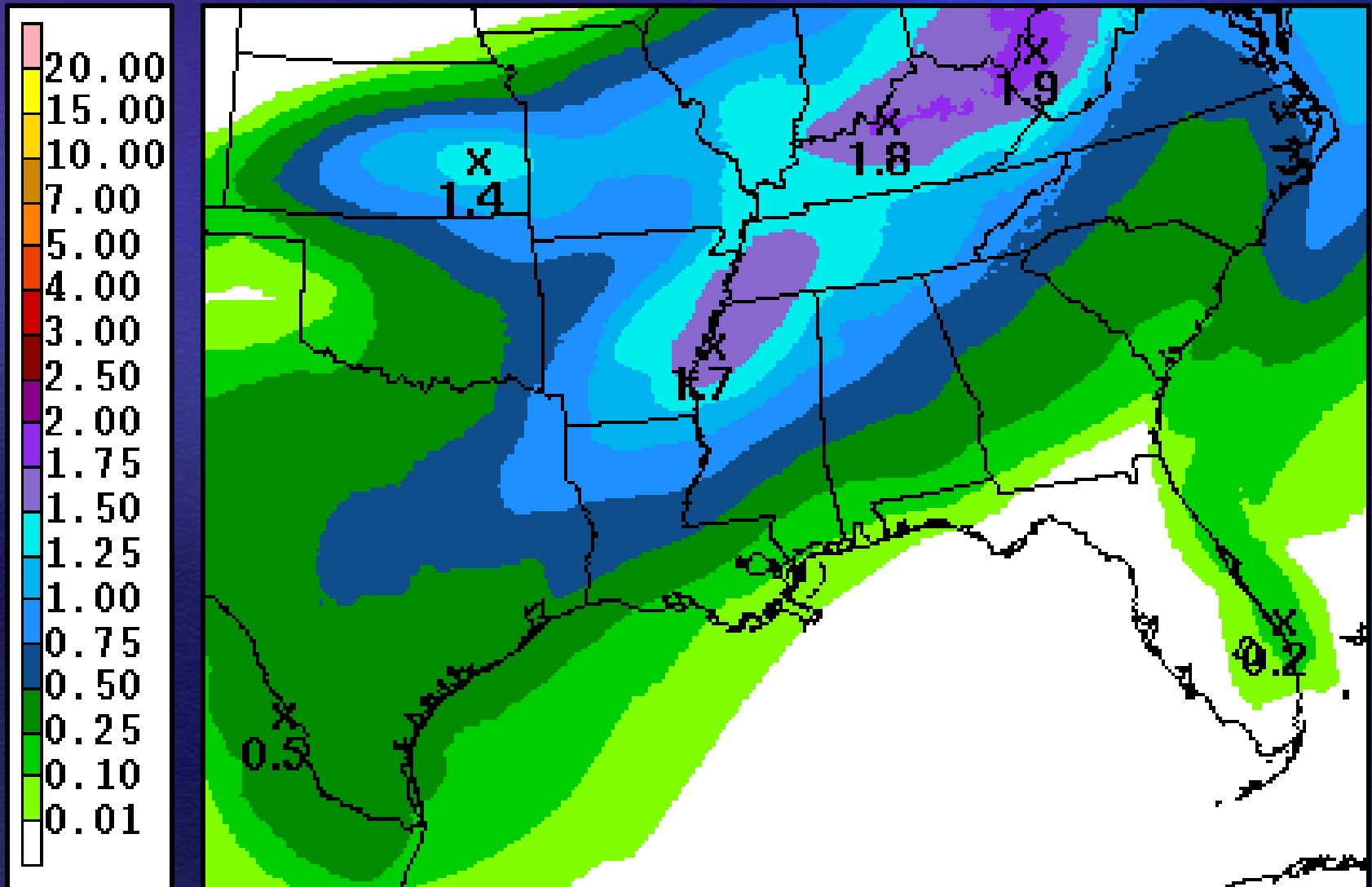


A weak trough of low pressure will bring a risk of scattered showers to the area Monday through Wednesday.

# Summary of Impacts

- Dense fog tonight and Friday night will be the biggest impact this week. Visibilities of less than  $1/4^{\text{th}}$  mile can be expected.
- Scattered showers will be possible Friday and Saturday and again next week. No heavy rainfall or severe weather is expected.
- Temps will remain above normal through Saturday before returning to more normal levels next week.
