The recent delays for not having worked on the bridge are two fold but ultimately very similar. When there is a blockage or obstruction, the scope of work changes a bit, and approval from the parish and the Army Corps of Engineers has to be attained. The crane being used cannot reach our side of the bridge to complete the work. This particular delay has been waiting for approval from parish, ACoE, and Volkert Engineering to cross the new side (the side that presently is partially complete) to work on our side. The crane will sit on what has been built to complete the work. It is expected that by Monday, Aug. 6, a resolution will have been decided.

Waste Connections, formerly Progressive Garbage Company, is promoting sales tomorrow and several weekends thereafter to offer their services to those residents who DO NOT presently use them.
