

Information from Levee Board. Meeting Wed. March 13, 2019

A quorum was met with 6 members present.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The important information presented was that within the next year the CPRA has approved an appropriation of 9 million dollars, 3 million for 3 months, to be used toward the cost of task two of the study for flood protection. Part two covers gap analysis in the coastal study which should include information collected with and without existing levees. The study should include the impact of the storm, the duration of flooding and the CAUSE using models. THE parish will receive the money and will be in control of the distribution of those funds.

THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD HERE IN SLIDELL at the Towers Bldg. on April 17, 2019, 6 P.M. I cannot ask, urge, beg you enough to attend.

Also John Faust pointed out that the levee board was left out in the section of the contract that makes decisions. Chairman Di Franco suggested that it was an oversight. Faust requested that it be corrected.
