Replies:

St. Tammany's engineering department is still reviewing our request for a right-turn lane and arrow exiting our bridge onto Moonraker Dr. Time involved: 1 year and 3 months

Public works department is still working on the locations for the extra streetlights. Meanwhile, if your streetlight is out, please call 985-898-2792. I requested an additional 4 lights in the back of Moonraker Dr.

I also requested 1 light on the side of Clipper Dr. leading toward the boulevard. It's very dark there after drivers make the turn from Moonraker to cross the bridge. The parish is waiting on CLECO's bid.

The drainage fund has increased to \$75,000.00 which will be used when Moonraker Dr. is replaced. The bid date has not yet been determined. I will stay on this. Meanwhile, I will request a repair where the street is actually eroded in the 200 area.
