Minutes having been provided at every table, Naomie Hess requested that attendees read over the minutes and asked for a motion to dispense with reading of those minutes. Motion made by Larry Lehan, Second by Linda Anderson. Motion carried Treasurer's report being very short and copies provided at every table was then read by Naomie. Having no questions or objections, the report was accepted.

Karen Lewis was introduced to members and she addressed them as to how happy she and her husband are to have become residents of this community and her being able to work with MICO. She will be updating the website and requested any pictures of activities in the community be sent to her for consideration of publication on the website.

Bonnie reported on the meeting with Pres. Pat Brister and her staff. This meeting was attended by Bonnie Peyroux, Naomie Hess and Tom Thompson. Among things discussed was: lighting of on/off I-10 ramp, completion of bridge repair, crime cameras, road repair of Moonraker, reestablishing covenants for Moonraker Island and the blocking of neighbors' views when pulling in or out of their driveway by vehicles parked in the easement.
