Meeting called to order by Bonnie Peyroux 7:08
Jeff offered a silent prayer and Pledge to the Flag

Bonnie introduced Sgt. Chad Risey - Community Liaison for District I of the Sheriff's Dept.

Treasurer's Report: report given by Linda Anderson - accepted by a show of hands of those members present

Minutes: A copy of the minutes was placed on tables for members to review. Secretary, Naomie Hess, asked for everyone to look over the minutes then asked if there were any objections - having none the minutes were accepted by show of hands of those members present

Flood Protection: Monies have been approved by Federal, State and Local governments. Must have voter approval for millage to maintain the system

Electrical Sign: Membership was informed that the Board would like to erect an electrical sign at the entrance of Moonraker to replace present signs that we post. Motion to look into the cost made by Michelle Leblanc and second by Jay Wood. - Motion passed

Flags - Jay Woods volunteered to post American Flags in Honor of Independence Day

Old Business:

Bonnie reported that Parish cut the canes at the second curve but expects MICO to keep them cut.

Speed Machine: Councilman Airey has the machine but cannot agree on exact location - wants to move it 24 ft. As soon as that is feasible it will be installed

Lighting: Because the Parish engineers cannot agree on exact location, lights have been withdrawn.

Drainage: to be repaired as soon as it is determined how to lay drains where homeowners have cemented areas along side of their homes

Turning Lanes: lanes on Moonraker/Clipper bridge should be done in a few weeks

Casino: no longer an issue

Moonraker Lake: power point presentation on the history of its development and when it was sold in spite of court ruling WITH PREJUDICE that it belongs to residents of Moonraker Island - it cannot be filled, dredged or otherwise have any change without a zoning change

Membership: present membership is 67 members! Need people to encourage others to join. Board cannot do all of this on our own. Sent 2 mailings out - 2nd netted only 4 new members.

Magnolia Water: when Naomie attempted to report the issues facing residents, Mary DuBission interrupted her (out of order) and shut her down.
