

On the Positive Side

<u>Financial Statement</u> – The Financial Report for period ending March 31st, First Quarter, is included with this newsletter.

<u>Playground</u> - The playground is being cleaned and prepared for the children. We have installed new swings and will refurbish the gym set and sand box this week.

<u>Landscape</u> – We are working diligently to make Victorian a nicer place to live. The grass is being cut on a regular basis and all the bushes and hedges have been trimmed for the first time in over a year. On the Negative Side

The Code Enforcement lawsuit is still pending. We are working every day on correcting the violations, but we still have not received all the assessment monies (Jefferson Parish Code Enforcement and Security Camera Assessment). Our process of collecting will escalate this month; any assessments that are not paid will be looked at as delinquent and your Condo Fees will not be accepted on June 1^{st.}

<u>Air Conditioners</u> – Many A/C units are leaking, please put a water catcher under your leaks. Maintenance men working during the day will keep them empty and you will have to empty them yourself at night and weekends. These leaks are causing balconies to rot and are posing a dangerous hazard.

<u>T.V. Discs</u> – Dishes are not allowed to be attached to our buildings. Please contact the Office before purchasing any satellites or cable.

Washers & Dryers – All illegal washing machines and dryers must be removed by May 30th 2010. Fines will be imposed on all owners who are in violation. If your unit is grandfathered in or if there is a handicap, you must contact the office to have it approved.

<u>Pets</u> – All pets must be leased when walking and you are responsible for cleaning your dog's mess. Fines will be imposed.
